Settings for New Quizzes:

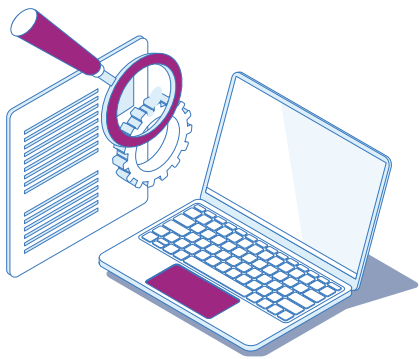


- In the quiz settings, have you selected 'Restrict student result view'?

This is to ensure students cannot see and therefore share the questions and/or correct/incorrect answers after they have taken the quiz

Settings for Assignments:

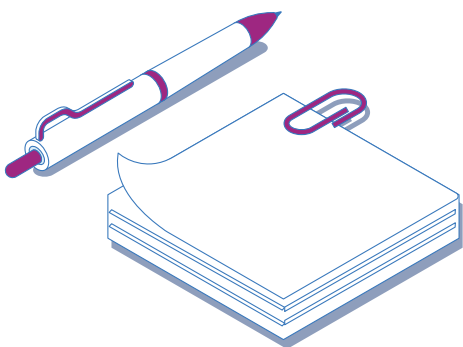


- In the module menu, is the "Files" Item hidden or have you ensured that any assessment files are restricted?

When you upload a file as part of an assignment it can be visible in the "Files" area unless this menu item is hidden
